

DAY OF PRAYER FOR BRITAIN - You may be aware that there is to be a day of prayer on Saturday, 31st August organised by the Ministry of David Hathaway. This is to be held at the SSE Arena, Wembley for 10.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. In view of the starting time, we have felt in our own Fellowship (Westergate Christian Fellowship) that it could be difficult if travelling by public transport to arrive comfortably on time, and we have consequently considered whether we could meet with members of other local churches in the area and join the people meeting in Wembley by live-streaming the day's events locally.
