

Sunday 11th July 2021 ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK

Following the Government's current guidelines and the subsequent advice from the Baptist Union, the church remains **open** for Sunday worship. We do, however, still need to follow the current restrictions which means, social distancing, masks, sanitiser, no singing and restricted numbers. We are restricted to around 40 worshippers – so you need to book a seat. As numbers are restricted, we will be continuing with our online services on Sundays and Wednesdays. This weekend, Simon returns to our series based on the "Prayer". The title of Simon's talk is "Prayer V – First Love" based around Revelation 2:1-5. and it is all to do with 'intimacy in prayer.' In this series we will be considering God's plans for His church and asking, "Why do we do what we do?" and "Is this what God really wants us to do?" This week Derek will be bringing us part 13 entitled, "Unfinished". This week's message comes from Acts chapter 28 but you may find it helpful to read through both Acts 27 and 28 before the service. You should find this talk very relevant to us today as there is little doubt that all churches need to make sure their ministry is biblically based. Historically, churches have moved their missional focus to supporting missionaries financially whereas God's church was set up to be a missionary force itself. Individually and corporately, we need to ask God to give us all a real heartfelt burden for the lost. This week, every week, put it on your prayer list.
