

Sunday 31st October 2021 GETTING BACK TO NORMAL ...

... but that really needs to be God's normal, not ours. So please be open to God's Holy Spirit leading us in directions that might not be so familiar to you. After all God has promised us that He is doing a new thing at ABC, and we need to be in tune with His directions. My talk today will be based on Jesus' statement, "I am the Light of the World" taken from John 8:12-20. This statement, along with the other "I am" statements, clearly identifies Jesus as God in human flesh. Perhaps because we are so familiar with the idea of Jesus being the light of the world, that we somehow minimise the enormity of this revelation. It is such a powerful statement that it demands a response from everyone but for the Pharisees this was one step too far and widen the gulf between the religious leaders of the day and Jesus.
