TREVOR GAUDOIN – Trevor’s funeral is on Friday at 11am. This is for family only. This will be followed by a thanksgiving service for Trevor’s life at the church beginning at 12noon. You are all invited to this service which will be followed by a cold buffet. Please pray for Doreen and the family at this difficult time.

WHO ARE THE DEACONS? - A group of men and women appointed by the church meeting to serve* with the Minister as a leadership team. Whilst the team cannot represent exactly, it is hoped that it will reflect the mix of gender, age and background within our fellowship. Our constitution says we should have up to 8 deacons – but currently we only have 5. Who would like to remedy this at our AGM in July. Do you know someone who could be a deacon? (*Deacon means servant - see Acts 6:1-4, 1 Timothy 3:8-13.)

GIFT AID – Although generally there is no such thing as a free gift, the government’s gift aid scheme gets pretty close. If you are a tax-payer, it means we can claim an extra 25p for every pound you give through your tithes and offerings. The scheme cost you nothing. You do have to make a Gift Aid declaration for the us to be able to claim. You do this by filling in a form which you can get from Peter Kaufman. In the last financial year, we were able to claim around £9000 – which is a significant amount!
