Yet he knew from the voice's self-description (*Alpha and Omega*) that it was Jesus. And yet as He turned and saw Jesus, John was so overwhelmed by what he saw that he fell at His (Jesus) feet as if dead. Of course, Jesus comforted John with a compassionate touch. Jesus tells John, as He tells, "Do not be afraid".

**SUNDAY EVENING** – This Sunday will be a 'Just Worship' evening – where we worship God simply for who he is. This evening will be centred around the words of Psalm 27:4 in which the Psalmist says that he asks one thing of the Lord – that he may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of his life to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord. #### A MESSAGE FROM SIMON ABOUT OUR APPROACH TO CORONAVIRUS

It would be better to not shake hands, and if you feel unwell for any reason, please stay at home on Sundays or whenever you might meet in a group.

However, what I will say, is that the Lord Jesus Christ is in charge of all of this and we need to keep praying for his power, protection and grace in this situation; not forgetting the world and our own country.
