

ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK



This Sunday, Simon's sermon is entitled "The anchored soul" based on Hebrews 6:19-20. In this sermon, Simon explains that in these uncertain time God wants us to know of the deep security we have in Him as believers – how anchored our souls really are. Simon specifically focuses on the phrase 'we have this hope as an anchor for the soul,' but without the background and context, we will not really appreciate the depths of what that anchor is like. The background all revolves around a man called Melchizedek, the man referred to in our verses - v20. Melchizedek was the King of Salem, and he appears in Genesis 14v18-20. And, other than in Genesis, he only appears once more in the Old Testament in Psalm 110v4! So, a man who is mentioned only twice in the entire Old Testament is a dominant theme in the book of Hebrews and in our verses! But why? To find out make tune you watch this weekend's service!

Our Sunday morning service will go "live" at 6pm on a Saturday evening. However, if possible, we would like you to join us on Sunday in prayer at around 10.20am before watching the service at 10.30am as normal. Please pray for your church family and for all the frontline workers who are keeping us going in these difficult times. It is becoming clear that, as the lockdown continues, people will become more agitated, so, as we said last week, we need to keep our eyes firmly fixed on Jesus.
