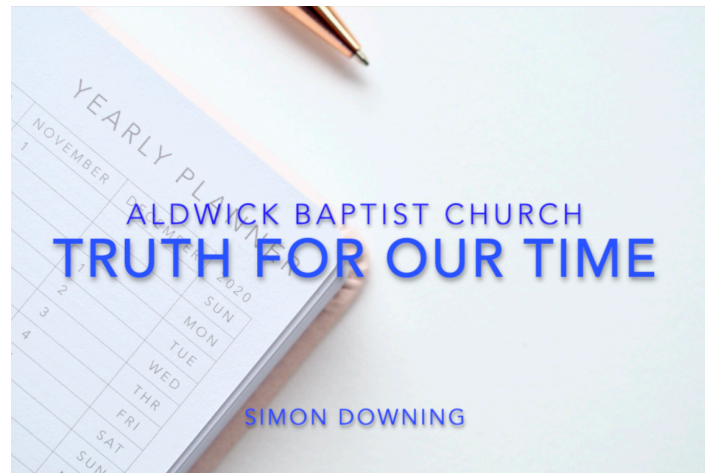

## ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK

This Sunday, our subject today comes under the title, 'truth for our time...' and it is going to focus on God's word, and how that can help us manage the time we are living in and our feelings. Everybody struggles to live in this world, and most people have depressive moments and anxieties. Of course, there are others who have chronic battles with it - lifelong struggles. But I hope that whatever degree of struggle yours may be, there will be something of use for you in this. The focus in the first part of my talk is a three specific Bible verse: Ephesians 1:6; Romans 8:31 and Hebrews 13:5. In the second half of the talk I will offer some practical ways to move forward.
