

ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK

Welcome to our Pentecost Sunday service! All the waiting and staring that the apostles had done, as our previous talks showed, were all a necessary part of what was to come. It was all about preparation for Pentecost – the famous theme of our text, Acts 2v1-21. Pentecost is associated with three major Jewish feasts. It is linked with the feast of Weeks, the feast of Harvest and the day of first fruits - Pentecost's Hebrew name is Shavuot. In itself, Pentecost was one of the 3 major Jewish festivals, so thousands upon thousands of Jews would have been in Jerusalem for this – the place would have been packed. And so, there they were - the Day of Pentecost had come – 49 days after the Sabbath of the Passover week had already passed, as it has always done, but *this* Pentecost would be like no other!


