Welcome to the week's news sheet. I hope you feel that our weekly sheet helps you to still feel part of our family at ABC even though are still unable to meet together. In today's sermon we will be looking at the phrase, '...in the Spirit.' I will be using a number of verses today, but the exact phrase 'in the Spirit...' appears in a number of places. For example, Ephesians 6v18 with regard to prayer, Revelation 1v10, 4v2, 17v3 and 21v10, with regard to John's prophetic vision and even Jude refers to it in v20, again with regard to prayer. Often, I have come across people who are concerned about the Spirit and many of them would rather leave such matters to other Christians, so please let me say this. Every single Christian is spiritual. Every single Christian has been created by God, to be spiritual. They are spiritual because they are 'in Christ...' and they have the Holy Spirit, dwelling in them, Romans 8v15ff. There are no exceptions to this, and it is nothing to do with what gifts one has.
