Suffering, perseverance, and character

Over many weeks, I have been trying to speak on what the Lord has directly led me to. So, rather than a series as such, I have focussed on specific and verses and themes. Today I want to look at the area of suffering, perseverance and character – for us as believers. I think this is a very important issue, something perhaps occasionally forgotten by The Church. Last week's talk called 'in all things', with the picture of the jigsaw, fits with today's sermon – so I feel the Lord has been leading us.

This week's talk fits closely to last week's talk - every jigsaw piece of your life is under God's sovereign hand, and he will conform you and me into the image of Jesus. Praise be to God then, even our sufferings He can and will use! For God has indeed poured out, gushed out, His love into our hearts. And we have hope – in triplicate the passage reads – so let us stand on it and in His love. Simon.

You can continue to meet in any outdoor space in a group of up to 6 people from different households.

So up to SIX people would be allowed to meet provided you follow the social distancing guidelines. **YOU SHOULD NOT MEET IN GROUPS OF MORE THAN SIX.**

The leadership team will be meeting online on Tuesday, July 14th, so please pray for God's guidance and His wisdom in making the right decisions.
