Sunday 20th December 2020 ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK

This weekend we will be worshipping both in church and online as we come together for our annual carol service. By now you know there can be no congregational singing in church and, of course, we will still have to restrict the numbers attending. Simultaneously, we will be holding our online carol service for those of us who remain at home. For home worshippers of course you can sing along to your hearts content, as well as eating mince pies and drinking mulled wine. Our Sunday morning service will go "live" at 6pm on a Saturday evening. However, if possible, we would like you to join us on Sunday in prayer at around 10.20am before watching the service at 10.30am as normal. Consequently, our Christmas day service will be pre-recorded and available only online from 10am on Christmas morning.

SERVICE, SUNDAY DECEMBER 27th - For the same reasons outlined above, the church will remain closed and this service on 27th December and will be available online only. Clive will be leading this service and the title of his talk will be, "Keep pressing on in Jesus' name" based on Philippians 3:10-14. This seems a particularly apt title as we move into a new year still under COVID10 restrictions.
