None of us want our church to be closed as we all enjoy meeting together as we listen to God's word – but we have to be sensible and keep safe. Consequently, our services will still be only available online although we do intend to **re-open** the church on Easter Sunday (more details inside). This Sunday, Simon continues with his series, "Names of God" as we reach "Names of God II - Yahweh Yireh" based on Genesis 22:1-18.
