ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK

Our Sunday morning service will go "live" at 6pm on a Saturday evening. However, if possible, we would like you to join us on Sunday in prayer at around 10.20am before watching the service at 10.30am as normal.

In our midweek series this week we begin a new 13 part series entitled, "Unstoppable – A journey through the Book of Acts".
