ABC ONLINE – TWICE A WEEK – EVERY WEEK

We are restricted to 35 worshippers (more details inside). As numbers are restricted, we will be continuing with our online services on Sundays and Wednesdays. This Sunday, Simon returns to our series based on the prayer. This week we Simon's talk is entitled, "Prayer II – The throne of grace". In this series we will be reemphasising both the importance of prayer in our lives but also the amazing truth that when you pray, God actually welcomes you into the very throne room of His grace.
