## A deeper worship – Psalm 100

**Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2022**

### Things are changing ...

As you probably know by now, the Government will be ending its Covid Plan B measures from next Thursday, with mandatory face coverings in public places and Covid passports both dropped. This means we will be reverting to measure outlined in Plan A. This means that we all need to continue taking steps to keep the virus at bay, including hand washing, ventilating rooms and self-isolating if you test positive. This should not be seen as the "finish line" because the virus and future variants cannot be eradicated - instead "we must learn to live with Covid in the same way we live with flu".

This almost certainly means that from Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> January, face coverings are no longer mandatory in our church and that wearing them will become optional and a matter of personal choice.
