

Things are changing ...

By now I am sure you all know that the Government has ended its Covid Plan B with mandatory face coverings in public places and Covid passports both dropped. This means we will be reverting to measure outlined in Plan A. This should not be seen as the "finish line" because the virus and future variants cannot be eradicated - instead "we must learn to live with Covid in the same way we live with flu".

The Baptist Union has advised their members to proceed with caution. This means that we all need to continue taking steps to keep the virus at bay, including hand washing, ventilating rooms and self-isolating if you test positive. In line with the new guidelines, face coverings are no longer mandatory in our church and that wearing them will become optional and a matter of personal choice. TODAY'S SERVICE – Simon's group will be leading the worship in today's service and Simon will also be preaching. His sermon is entitled "Moses and his radiant face" and will be based on Exodus 34:29-35.
