AN APPEAL FOR FUNDS FOR UKRAINE - We are most concerned about the current situation in Ukraine and realise that there is a great need to support those affected by the Russian invasion. To that end we, as a church, will of course be praying for the whole Ukrainian situation but we would also like to make a donation through the Barnabas Ukraine appeal fund. As an example – a gift of £15 will pay for a food package that could last a young couple with a child for about a week, or an elderly couple on their own for two weeks. The food package will contain rice, pasta, buckwheat (a very traditional food staple in Ukraine), canned fish, canned beans, condensed milk, cooking oil, tea and more. If you feel able to support this appeal, you can make a donation of cash in the Perspex back at the back of the church, or by cheque or by bank transfer. If you need further details, please ask me.
