Pentecost

Acts 2:1-11

TODAY'S SERVICE – In today's family service we will be celebrating the coming of the Holy Spirit onto the Apostles as they were celebrating the Jewish festival Shavuot. Christians now call this celebration Pentecost which occurs on the Sunday fifty days after Easter. Pentecost Sunday is regarded as the birthday of the Christian church and the start of the church's mission to the world. Although "church" may have changed over the centuries, Jesus' final instructions to the church has not. We are to "go and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
