Series: What do I do when I feel ...?

Leviticus 16:20-22; Colossians 2:13-15, 1 John 1:8-9

TODAY'S SERVICE – In today's service we return to our series, "What do I do when I feel ...?" This morning Simon asks a question everyone in the world faces many times over in their life. "What do we do when I feel sinful?"

Simon's talk will come in two parts. In part 1, Simon will be looking at what the Bible means by sin. In part 2, Simon will be telling what the Bible says we should do when we do recognise our sin. But He will also be looking at what the Bible says God will do if we truly repent, As 1 John 1v8-9 reads: 'if we confess our sins, he (God) is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.' Of course, God does this because of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. Sounds both important and intriguing, so don't miss it.

GIFT AID – Although generally there is no such thing as a free gift, the government's gift aid scheme gets pretty close. If you are a tax-payer, it means we can claim an extra 25p for every pound you give through your tithes and offerings. The scheme cost you nothing. You do have to make a Gift Aid declaration for the us to be able to claim. You do this by filling in a form which you can get from Peter Kaufman. In the last financial year, we were able to claim around £9000 – which is a significant amount!
