TODAY'S WORSHIP SERVICE – This morning Simon will be leading us in worship as well as bringing us the next in our series, "The Unveiling" based on John's Gospel. Today's reading is John 3:1-10 and the title of Simon's talk is "Regeneration". In this passage Jesus spoke these life-changing words: "Unless a man is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." And yet, the man to whom Jesus was speaking was a very religious leader of the Jews, a teacher who read his Bible, worshipped on the right days, and tried to keep the commandments of God. As far as Nicodemus was concerned, he was doing everything right - so what was Nicodemus doing wrong? Are we making the same mistake? This is a highly significant moment in Jesus' ministry, so don't miss this!
