

THIS WEEKEND'S WORSHIP SERVICE – In today's service Simon concludes our series from John's Gospel entitled the "The Unveiling". His final talk is based on John 7:37-39 and is entitled "The Unveiling – Inflow". At the conclusion of the service, Simon would like us all to be anointed with oil and to receive a short personal prayer asking God to send His Holy Spirit on each one us. In other words to infill us with streams of living water in a new way so that each one of us becomes more aware of the Holy Spirit in our lives than we have ever done before, and that we will have greater *confidence* in the things of the Spirit.

For any who physically can't come out, one of deacons will come to you wherever you are in the church and ask if you would like to be anointed and receive a short prayer.

And please note... no one is under *any pressure or obligation!* If you choose not to be involved with this, then no one will think anything less of you, because there may be very good reasons why you do not feel able to participate. It is not a problem!

So, let us be at peace over this! Let us trust Jesus, who is ready to bless through His kindness.
