We are seen by the heart failure team there every 6 weeks and we couldn't wish to be in better care.

Lucia has gone back to school full time and last week we had a very positive result from one of her blood tests. Because of this result we decided it was safe for her to go back to "Saturday Stage School" - something that she has missed very much!

Your prayers, thoughts, gifts & well wishes have truly meant so so so much to us all - once again, thank you!!!
