BOLD WITNESS – ENCOURAGING EVERY BELIEVER TO EVANGELISE - Next Sunday we begin this new series in Matthew 28 where Jesus gives His disciples and all Christians that follow their instructions to go and make disciples of all nations. Now before you panic, in this series we not only want to emphasise the importance of this commission but to encourage you to see this as an opportunity to work with the Holy Spirit in sharing the good news that Jesus really is the Lord of creation. We want to make sharing the Gospel an enjoyable experience for you and those people you meet wherever that is. So do come and listen to what God has to say.
