Please pray for:

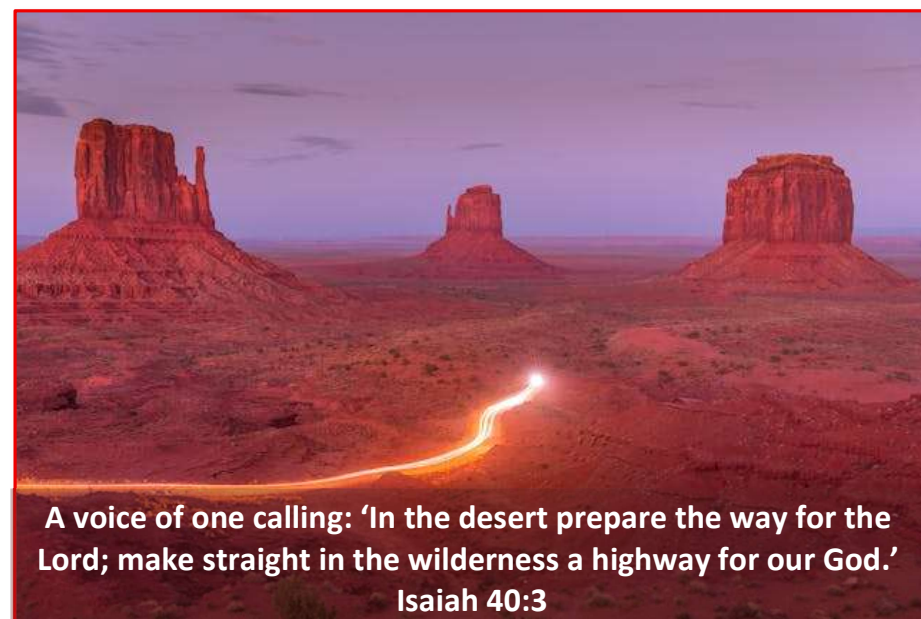
