Please remember the family of Angela Halfacree in your prayers as they mourn her passing.

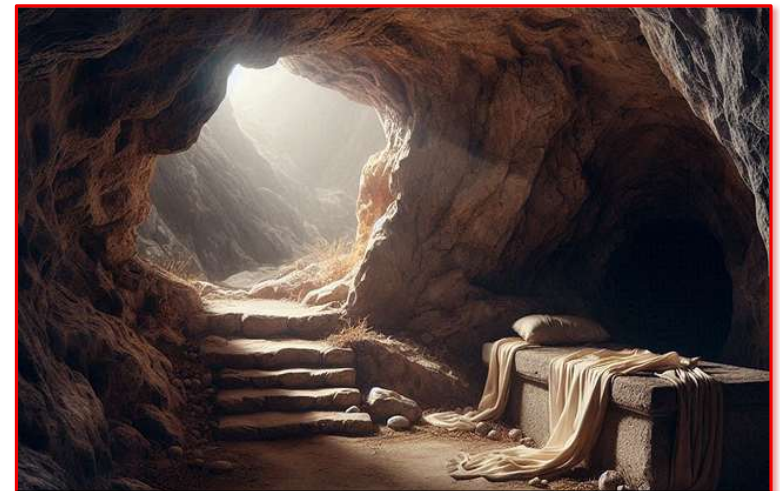
Please also hold Heather and Philip Gaudoin in prayer as they come to terms with the loss of their brother Andre.
